FULL TIME REGISTERED SANITARIAN or SANITARIAN-IN-TRAINING

The Adams County Health Department is seeking applicants for a full time Registered Sanitarian or Sanitarian-in-Training position. The Sanitarian will perform entry level, generalist duties in the enforcement of environmental and public health laws. The duties may include the inspections of onsite sewage treatment systems, private water systems, food service operations, retail food establishments, vending food locations, public swimming pools, campgrounds, tattoo and body piercing studios, schools, day care facilities, investigate animal bites, housing, solid waste and smoking complaints, assist in the investigation of food-borne or other disease outbreaks. This position may require the working of some evening and weekends to conduct inspections or attend meetings.

QUALIFICATIONS

Bachelor's degree in Environmental Health Science or a related science (Biology, Chemistry, Geology, etc.) with at least 45 quarter hours or 30 semester hours of science related courses as required by Ohio Revised Code 4736.08. Must obtain a license to function as a Sanitarian-in-Training within 30 days of hire date if not already licensed as a Registered Sanitarian or Sanitarian-in-Training. Must possess a valid Ohio driver's license and maintain a driving record that meets insurability requirements and have proof of insurance on personal vehicle.

ADDITIONAL SKILLS

A general working knowledge of Microsoft Office programs; general use of computer, telephone, copier, fax and projector; good public speaking skills; project a positive and professional attitude and image to clients and other staff

WORKING CONDITIONS

This position will require field work to be conducted as part of the inspection process. The employee may be exposed to, must negotiate, use and work in the vicinity of: hot, cold, humid and windy conditions; extreme non-weather related heat and cold; upset and emotionally distraught individuals; disease investigations; commercial kitchen hazards; hazardous driving conditions; commercial cleaning solutions; pool maintenance chemicals; raw sewage, human waste, insects and other unsanitary conditions; trenches, ditches, and other excavations; frequently lifts objects 25 pound or less; frequently carries objects 25 pound or less; occasionally pushes or lift objects 50 pound or less.
